From our home base at the University of Adelaide's Elder Conservatorium of Music, where we are Quartet-in-Residence, we reach out across Australia and the world to engage people with an outstanding program of performances, workshops, commissions, digital content, recording and education projects.

Our distinct sound is enhanced by a matched set of 18th century Guadagnini instruments, handcrafted by Giovanni Battista Guadagnini between c.1743 and 1784 in Turin and Piacenza, Italy. These precious instruments are on loan for our exclusive use through the generosity of UKARIA.
